Ximena Alarcón is a sound artist-researcher interested in listening to our sonic migrations: in-between sonic spaces manifested in dreams, under-

ground public transport and cultural and technological mediations in the migratory context. She is a *Deep Listening* tutor, with a PhD in Music Technology and Innovation. Throughout her career, she has created telematic sonic improvisations and interfaces for relational listening, to understand sensorially her and others' migratory experience, as if in search of a collective interface that holds such sonic in-betweeness
